83482	Feature Enhancement	N/A	EV Mail	Improvements in handling HTML-only email notifications received via EVMail	<p>There are two new parameters for EVMail configuration configured within the EVMail task:</p> <p>1 - EVMAIL_ALLOW_HTML_MSG - valid values are YES, NO and PARSE. If this is not specified, the default value is PARSE</p> <p>2 - EVMAIL_ALLOW_HTML_MSG_FAIL_TEMPLATE - used only if above parameter is NO. If it does not exist, then SMTP_MSG_FAIL_TEMPLATE is used, if it exists.</p> <p>The behavior is:</p> <p>1 - Accept HTML mail as is, and place it into an HTML area field, trying to preserve the formatting - the assumption is that you are mainly receiving short emails, and you want to attempt to preserve HTML constructions such as tables and links</p> <p>2 - Strip the incoming HTML-formatted mail of HTML tags, and place the contents into a text area or comments field. ExtraView will parse the text, removing as much HTML as possible. This is not a perfect solution, as some tags may not be recognized and any poor HTML may not be rejected.</p> <p>3 - Reject the incoming HTML-only mail and send back to the submitter a rejection notice</p>
83775	Feature Enhancement	N/A	LDAP	Modify EDIT_SCREEN_LDAP_FIELDS functionality to only perform lookup when the user field changes	<p>The configuration property LDAP_EDIT_FIELDS_CHANGE_ON_REFRESH = NO changes the behavior of the LDAP edit field updates by modifying the fields ONLY when the parent user field changes, not when the edit screen is first rendered nor when the edit screen is refreshed, as is done otherwise. This is new functionality</p>

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83778	Feature Enhancement	N/A	Search / Report	New ability to filter query results on summary reports to display Top N results (e.g. Top 10, Top 5 results)	The field, EV_TOP_RANK, when used as a filter in a summary report, returns ranked results based on the filter operator and value. To get the top ten, for example, a filter of EV_TOP_RANK <= 10 would be used. This means that only the top ten-ranked (according to the item counts) results will be returned. Ties are included. Therefore, this may return more than 10 rows.
77303	Product Bug	6.0.4	API & CLI	evhist -p option was not working	This option, which allowed the user to specify a specific report to validate the fields returned by the server, as opposed to using the detailed report was not functioning. This has been fixed.
77274	Product Bug	6.0.4	Add & Edit	After pressing the Enter key while doing QuickEdit in a user popup field, the current user was signed out	This happened in the unusual configuration where the Quickedit was configured on a related issue display, and it was the only field on the display. When this happened, the ENTER key would cause a session expiry, resulting in the user being signed out of the system. This has been fixed.
80589	Product Bug	6.1	Add & Edit	Popup user fields were not triggering rules when a name was typed in by the user as opposed to being picked from the popup list	If an administrator configured a rule based on a user field which was being displayed in a popup list, then the rule would not be triggered if the user typed in the name as opposed to picking it from a list. This has been fixed.
83561	Product Bug	6.1	Add & Edit	Recursion error in Ajax refresh	Ajax refresh within an add or edit screen was failing when there was a poorly configured layout with a looping in parent-child dependencies. Although this should not have been configured such that a loop in dependencies occurred, the underlying code has been altered so the problem will not occur.
77277	Product Bug	6.0.4	Administration	Access to fields within a Project when the user's role did not have permission	In the 6.0 release PROJECT field-level security permissions were introduced. This problem manifested itself in the project title still being displayed in the list of projects when the user did not have permission to a project. However, the field level security permission worked correctly, therefore no data to which the user did not have permission was ever displayed.
73650	Product Bug	6.0.4	Quickedit	Scroll bars did not disappear after finishing a Quickedit session on a related issue display	This problem was intermittent, but with some layouts of a specific size it happened frequently. The scroll bars that appeared correctly for a Quickedit session did not disappear when the Quickedit session ended.
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
